## Billy Goss--Head Coach

Goss was named as the head baseball coach at Tech in the fall of 1998. In his first two seasons at Tech, Billy Goss guided the Wonder Boys to back-to-back 20-win seasons. In 2001, Goss took it up a notch, leading Tech to a 32-20 overall record and an appearance in the championship round of the Gulf South Conference Tournament. The Wonder Boys' run in the GSC Tournament was Tech's best-ever showing in the event, reaffirming the Wonder Boys' position as one of the top baseball programs in the conference. Tech made it back to the postseason in 2004, finishing with a 31-23 overall record and an appearance in the GSC Tournament at USA Stadium in Millington, Tenn. In 2005, Goss guided the Wonder Boys to a 28-22 record and a second place finish in the Gulf South Conference and earned a trip to the GSC conference tournament.

## Chris Curry--Hitting

Curry joined the Arkansas Tech coaching staff in the fall of 2007 after a successful 9 year stint in professional baseball. Coach Curry played in the Chicago Cubs and San Francisco Giants organizations making it as high as Triple-A. Before entering the professional ranks, Coach Curry was a member of the Meridian Community College (1997-98) and Mississippi State University (1999) baseball programs. Curry is in his first year as Tech's Baseball Hitting Coach.

## Will McCrotty - Infield/Pitching/Hitting

McCrotty joined the Arkansas Tech coaching staff in the fall of 2007 after a successful 8 year stint in professional baseball. Coach McCrotty was a 6th Round Draft pick in 1997 by the Los Angeles Dodgers. Coach McCrotty played in the Los Angeles Dodgers and Cleveland Indians organizations making it as high as Double-A. Coach McCrotty is in his first year as Tech's Baseball Infield/Pitching/Hitting Coach.

## Wes McCrotty--Pitching

McCrotty joined the coaching staff of Arkansas Tech in the summer of 2005 and is in his second stint at Tech. During the 2004-05 season, he was at the University of Arkansas working with Coach Jorn and the pitching staff.

After a four-year career at the University of Arkansas (1998-2001), he was drafted by the Florida Marlins. He spent two years with the Florida Marlins and one year with the Rockford Riverhawks as a pitcher.
