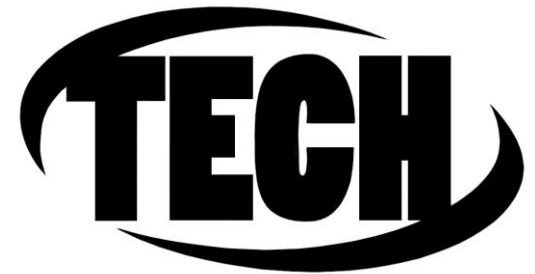

Wes McCrotty-- Pitching
 McCrotty was a four-year letter winner (1998-01) in baseball at the University of Arkansas as a pitcher and first baseman. Following his career with the Razorbacks, McCrotty was drafted in the 23rd round of the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft by the Florida Marlins and played two seasons (2001-02) Marlins organization. In 2003, played one season with the Rockford RiverHawks in the Independent Frontier League. Following his professional career, McCrotty worked as a volunteer with the University of Arkansas Baseball team during the 2005 season. McCrotty is entering his fourth-season as an assistant coach with the Wonder Boys as he began his coaching career as a volunteer assistant in 2004 and was hired as a full-time assistant in July of 2005. At Tech, McCrotty works with the pitchers, including former Wonder Boy Aubrey Miller, who was drafted in the 23rd round of the 2006 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles.

Blake Pizan—Hitting/Catching
 Blake Pizan is entering his first season as an assistant coach at Arkansas Tech University. Pizan will work with the Arkansas Tech hitters and catchers. Coach Pizan was a graduate of Pulaski Academy High School, where he was a four time all conference selection and all state selection his senior year in baseball and football. He played baseball at Arkansas Tech University from 2000-2004. During the same time he volunteered as the head baseball coach for American Legion's Arkansas Trailer/ Post #1 Red for five years. Pizan was a hitting and pitching instructor at Competitive Edge Sports Academy under Pat Harrison. In August of 2006 he became the head baseball coach at El Dorado High School, where he tied the school record for wins with 23 in 07' and took them farther in the playoffs than the school has been in 17 years.

Jantzen Black—Outfield/Hitting
 Black is entering his first season as a student-assistant coach at Arkansas Tech University. Black had a stand-out career at Arkansas Tech as an OF/INF. Black was two-time GSC All-Conference selection and was an All-Region selection his senior year at Tech. During his

senior year, Black hit in an unprecedented 31 game hitting streak while hitting .452 with 18 doubles and 4 home runs.
