LIL' SUNS CAMP

The camp teaches the basic fundamentals of basketball: ball handling, passing and shooting. Camp will begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 1:00 p.m. each day. Campers need to bring a sack lunch each day. Each camper will receive a Golden Suns Basketball Camp t-shirt!

Cost per Camper: Commuter \$80.00

INDIVIDUAL SKILLS CAMP

The Fundamental Camp is designed to build fundamental skills in all aspects of the game of basketball. The camp is geared to the athlete's current level of competition and builds to their next level of competition. Each player will receive individual instruction through drills, and competitive games. Campers will be classified according to grade level and will compete in their age division unless she chooses to play up. Also, segments of each day session will be devoted to position work. Former and current Golden Suns players, the Suns' staff and a great group of coaches will give instruction and foresight into playing point guards, off guards, forwards, or post positions.

TEAM CAMP

Tech Team Camp offer coaches a unique opportunity to compete against other teams in summer competition. The camps are divided into Junior High and Senior High divisions. Teams will be classified according to level of play and classification. Each team will compete in a round robin pool to determine seeding for the tournament play. All games will be officiated by floor officials, a time keeper, and a score keeper.

A \$100.00 deposit will hold a spot for your team for either team camp. There will be only 72 spots per camp. One coach per team will be allowed to stay free in the dorm and all meals for the coach will be free.

SHOOTING CAMP

The camp teaches the basic fundamentals of the shot, 3 point shooting, guard/post moves and 1 on 1 moves.. Camp will go from 2:00 to 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 30th. Camp will resume on Friday, July 31st at 9:00 a.m. Awards Ceremony: 2:00 p.m. Campers need to bring a sack dinner on July 30th and a sack lunch on July 31st.

CAMPUS POLICY

Campers participating in Arkansas Tech University sponsored camps must remain on the University campus unless the camper checks out of camp with a parent, legal guardian, coach, or staff member. This policy shall also apply to commuter campers. If a camper fails to follow this policy, her parent/legal guardian must assume all liability responsibility.

CHECK POLICY

We will accept money orders, coaches or school personal checks or cash at any time.

NECESSITIES

Each camper will furnish their own bed linens, pillows, blankets, towels, and personal items. Campers must furnish all workout gear. Casual wear is recommended while at camp. Please bring two pair of shoes - one for wearing in the gym, the other for use to and from the gym.

FACILITIES

Campers will be housed in one of Tech's modern air-conditioned dorms. Coaches and counselors will be housed in the dorm facility and will be available for the camper's needs. The camp menu has been upgraded and will be served buffet style in the Chambers Cafeteria. The main camp sessions are held in Tucker Coliseum, a 3,500 seat arena that is the home site of all Golden Suns Games. Sessions are also held in the Hull Building, a physical education facility just north of the football stadium. Both Hull and Tucker Coliseum are air-conditioned and easily accessible.

All camp sessions are open to the public and parents/friends are encouraged to attend.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

Each camper is covered by a secondary \$25.00 deductible excess medical insurance policy. A secondary excess policy simply means that the camper's insurance policy is the primary coverage and that the excess camp policy will pay what the primary policy will not. The insurance policy is an accidental policy and will not cover illness. **Only injuries occurring while the camper is enrolled in camp will be covered** - injuries received prior to the date of camp and injuries occurring after the camp has ended will not be covered under this policy. The deductible must be paid before the camper checks out of camp if there is an injury report filed.

PRE-REGISTRATION DEPOSIT AND REFUND POLICY

Individual campers may secure their place in camp or camps by paying a \$35.00 pre-registration deposit per camp. Anytime prior to the start of the camp entered, the camper only has to pay the remaining portion to be officially enrolled in camp. The pre-registration deposit is non-refundable because it secures that camper a place in camp. In case a camper pays the entire amount prior to the start of camp and cannot attend, she may request and receive a refund for everything but the cost of the pre-registration deposit (\$35.00). **This refund request must be in writing and must be received by the camp director prior to the start of camp.**
