2005 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

GSC POWER UNA ADVANCES TO NCAA FOOTBALL SEMI-FINALS

Birmingham, AL—For the fifth time in six years, a Gulf South Conference football squad has reached the Semi-Finals of the NCAA Division II Playoffs.

North Alabama (11-2) journeyed to the Natural State, outlasting **GSC Champion Central Arkansas** (11-3) in overtime, 41-38, thanks to Yuta Fukuda's game-winning, 45-yard field goal.

UNA advances to its second Semi-Final in three years. The win was sweet revenge for the Lions, who dropped a double-overtime decision in a GSC-TV Game of the Week at UCA during the regular season.

Next up for the No. 6 South Region seed Lions is No. 6 Southwest seed Northwest Missouri State, which topped 2004 NCAA Finalist Pittsburg State, 21-10. North Alabama hosts Saturday's Semi-Final at 10:00 am (Central), and fans around the country will get a chance to see it thanks to the NCAA's production company, which has placed the game on ESPNU (check with your local cable system or satellite provider for availability).

A total of 19 different football-playing schools have belonged to the GSC at some point since 1973; 12 of those have earned at least one Playoff bid. GSC teams have won 71 games during that span for a .634 winning percentage (71-41). In fact, nine* of the last 21 national champions were GSC members, seven from the North Central Conference, three from the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association and two from the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The GSC holds the playoff record for different schools to win the championship game (6), championship game appearances (14) and different schools to appear in the championship game (6). *—Mississippi College's 1989 national championship was vacated for NCAA infractions.

#6 SEED NORTH ALABAMA 41, @ #5 SEED CENTRAL ARKANSAS 38 (NCAA QUARTER-FINALS)

No. 6 seed North Alabama (11-2) won the NCAA South Region Title in dramatic fashion, clipping GSC Champion and **No. 5 seed Central Arkansas** (11-3) in overtime, 41-38.

The squads battled back and forth until **UNA placekicker Yuta Fukuda** booted the game-winning, 45-yard field goal in overtime. The victory marked the second time in as many weeks that the Lions advanced via a game-winning field goal.

The Lions took a 28-14 edge into the locker room, highlighted by a 14-0 first-quarter lead. **Running back DeMarcus Blount** posted the first touchdown from five yards out at 7:41 and **tight end Chip Long's** added a four-yard scoring grab with 2:45 left in the opening stanza. UCA notched its first TD just six seconds into the second frame when **tight end Austin Cade** hauled-in a 28-yard strike, but the Lions answered with back-to-back touchdown receptions by Long. North Alabama used a bit of trickery in Long's first score when **wide receiver Anthony Merritt** connected with the tight end from 21 yards out and Long followed with a 35-yard TD from **back-up quarterback A.J. Milwee**.

The Bears did not give up, cutting the lead in half at the break via **running back Willie Hopson's** one-yard jaunt. Central Arkansas shifted into high gear from there, reeling-off 31 unanswered points en route to a 38-28 lead with 8:07 left to play. **Placekicker James Paul** started the second-half comeback, nailing a 38-yard field goal with just over nine minutes left in the third quarter and **wide out Michael Norvell** reeled-in a 56-yard scoring bomb at 1:05. **UCA running back Kentrel Rogers** notched a 31-yard rushing TD just 34 seconds into the final quarter and Hopson capped the scoring streak with a 14-yard rush at 8:07.

North Alabama pulled within three with 5:34 left to play on **Gregory Clark's** four-yard touchdown reception and Fukuda forced overtime, connecting from 32 yards out with 1:52 on the clock. The Central Arkansas offense took the field first in the extra period, but UCA opened the door for Fukuda's heroics, missing a 42-yard field goal.

Long led all players with three touchdowns and added a team-high 100 yards receiving on six catches. Blount added 89 yards on 19 carries and Milwee connected on 3-of-4 passes for 43 yards and three TDs. Merritt caught a game-best seven balls for 54 yards and set the NCAA single-game kick returns (66).

The victory was sweet revenge for North Alabama which fell at Central Arkansas in double-overtime during the regular season. UNA snapped UCA's eight-game home winning streak while upping its overall streak to five.

Last meeting: First Meeting

North Alabama and Northwest Missouri State meet for the first time, but the teams have taken similar paths to the NCAA Playoff Semi-Finals.

Both squads advanced to the Final Four after earning No. 6 seeds in their regional brackets and winning three straight road contests, including last weekend's revenge triumphs over league rivals. UNA clipped GSC Champion Central Arkansas in overtime, 41-38, while NWMSU upended Pittsburg State, 21-10.

North Alabama returns home for the first time in three weeks and have a perfect 5-0 home mark this season, while Northwest Missouri State has reeled-off five consecutive road victories. The contest is the first meeting between the schools, but UNA is familiar with Mid-America Athletic Association foes. The Lions have a 3-2 all-time mark versus MIAA opponents, highlighted by a victory in their lone post-season battle, 27-7 over Pittsburg State in 1995. The GSC and MIAA have met four times in the NCAA post-season with each coming at the Championship Game and the GSC claiming a 3-1 edge. Valdosta State beat Pittsburg State in the last meeting, winning the 2004 Title Game, 36-31.

ESPNU is set to televise the game thanks to NCAA Productions. North Alabama hopes the third time is the charm after suffering a 0-2 record in televised contests this year as part of the GSC-TV Game of the Week package.

North Alabama is first in the GSC in scoring defense (17.3) and pass defense (187.5) and second in scoring offense (37.3), rushing defense (100.4) and total defense (287.9). Northwest Missouri State is second in the MIAA in passing offense (256.2) and rushing defense (125.4), third in total defense (330.6) and fifth in scoring offense (392.0).

Individually, **UNA quarterback Vinnie Saylor** is first in the league in passing touchdowns (27), second in total offense (254.2) and third in passing (245.9). **Wide receiver Anthony Merritt** is second in receptions (5.69) and fourth in receiving (66.8), while also ranking tops in all purpose yards (162.6) and kick return average (25.8). **Tight end Chip Long** comes off a three-touchdown effort last weekend and is fourth in receptions (4.69). **Running back DeMarcus Blount** is second in rushing TDs (14) and eighth in rushing yards (73.5). Quarterback Josh Lamberson leads the NWMSU offense, placing second in the MIAA in passing (245.8) and third in total offense (248.1). His top target is Andre Rector, who is first in receptions (6.46) and receiving (88.2).

NCAA SECOND ROUND--SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 19

#5 SEED CENTRAL ARKANSAS 52, @ #1 SEED PRESBYTERIAN 28 (NCAA SECOND ROUND)

No. 5 seed Central Arkansas (11-2) journeyed to upset top seed SAC Champion Presbyterian (10-2), 52-20, racking up 648 yards of total offense.

PC scored a touchdown on its opening possession but UCA answered with back-to-back touchdown catches by **wide receiver Aaron Fairouz**. Fairouz hauled-in a 22 yard pass at 10:38 and grabbed a 69-yard bomb at 8:56. The Blue Hose tied matters with 4:28 left in the first quarter but the Bears took control from there, hitting for 21 unanswered points. **Darren Shaw** caught an 11-yard TD pass with 1:14 left in the quarter, **wide out Ben Faires** reeled in an eight yarder at 10:06 in the second stanza and **running back Kentrel Rogers** found paydirt from two yards out with 3:49 remaining in the half. Presbyterian cut the lead to 14 in third quarter on an interception return for a touchdown, but Central Arkansas used a 10-point fourth quarter to ice the victory.

UCA quarterback Nathan Brown completed 23-of-32 passes for 495 yards and a school record tying six touchdowns. Faires caught a game-best six passes, including two touchdowns, while **Che Jones** added five catches for a game-high 144 yards. The Bears handed PC its first home loss of the season and upped their winning streak to seven.

#6 SEED NORTH ALABAMA 24, @ #2 SEED NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL 21 (NCAA SECOND ROUND)

No. 6 seed North Alabama (10-2) rallied from a 21-14, fourth-quarter deficit, squeaking past No. 2 seed CIAA Champion North Carolina Central (10-2), 24-21.

UNA took a 7-0 lead in the first quarter when **wide receiver Jaron Fountain** grabbed a 32-yard touchdown reception just 1:10 into the contest. NCCU answered just 43 seconds into the second stanza, but the Lions responded with **wide out Anthony Merritt's** 61-yard TD catch just under a minute later. The Eagles entered the locker room with a 21-14 lead, closing the first-half with back-to-back touchdowns. North Alabama's defense flexed its muscle in the second half, shutting out the hosts, allowing the offense to surge ahead thanks to a 10-point fourth quarter thanks to unlikely heroes. **Back-up quarterback A.J. Milwee** led UNA on a game-tying touchdown drive, capped by **running back DeMarcus Blount's** 23-yard rush at 8:27. **Back-up placekicker Beau Tanner** picked a perfect time to make his first field goal of the season, nailing the game-winning 37-yard boot as time expired.

Blount led all rushers with 137 yards and a score on 19 attempts, while Merritt added a team-high five catches for 82 yards and a TD. The victory moved North Alabama's NCAA Playoff record to 21-7 and preserved its 5-0 mark versus CIAA foes.

NCAA FIRST ROUND--SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 12

#5 SEED CENTRAL ARKANSAS 28, @ #4 SEED ALBANY STATE 20 (NCAA FIRST ROUND)

No. 5 seed Central Arkansas (10-2) earned its first-ever NCAA Football Playoff win, clipping homestanding **No. 4 seed Albany State** (8-2), 28-20.

UCA trailed twice in the first half deficits and overcame a plague of first-quarter interceptions, thanks to 21 unanswered points. ASU struck first on Antonio Atkins' 56-yard TD rush in the first quarter, but the Bears answered on **running back Kentrel Rogers'** three-yard plunge at 10:27 in the second stanza. Atkins responded with a 69-yard scoring catch just over a minute later, but Central Arkansas tied matters at intermission when **tight end Austin Cade** hauled-in a five-yard touchdown catch.

UCA used some trickery to capture its first lead of the game, when Cade reeled-in a two-yard score on a fake field goal at 8:53 in the third quarter and **running back Willie Hopson** followed with a 16-yard run at 4:56. The Golden Rams did not give up, pulling within six with 4:36 left to play, but they missed the extra-point attempt and that's as close as the SIAC champs would come.

Hopson led the squad with 110 yards and one score on 19 carries, while Rogers added 82 yards and a TD. Cade added a game-high tying five catches for 44 yards and two touchdowns. **Wide receiver Aaron Fairouz** caught two balls, setting the school's single season receptions record (68). Central Arkansas won the first-ever meeting versus Albany State, giving the school its first 10-win season since moving to the Division II ranks.

#6 SEED NORTH ALABAMA 40, @ #3 SEED VALDOSTA STATE 13 (NCAA FIRST ROUND)

No. 6 seed North Alabama (9-2) won the battle of GSC powers, upsetting **No. 3 seed Valdosta State** (9-3), 40-13.

The squads were tied 10-10 in the second quarter, but UNA outscored VSU 30-3 over the final 40 minutes. The Lions got off to a rough start, fumbling the opening kickoff, which the Blazers turned a touchdown when **running back Vincent Brown** found the endzone from two yards out just 1:18 into the contest. North Alabama took a 10-7 lead on a 28-yard field goal by **Yuta Fukuda** at 7:24 and Jason Messing's 30-yard touchdown catch with just 39 seconds left in the quarter.

Valdosta State tied matters on **Michael Green's** 31-yard field goal at 11:42 in the second stanza, but UNA took a 23-10 halftime edge thanks to **Blake Farris'** two-yard fumble recovery at 9:28 and **Anthony Merritt's** 31-yard reception at 4:09. Green closed the gap to 10 with 8:15 left in the third frame, but the Lions pulled away scoring 17 unanswered points in the fourth quarter. Fukuda nailed a 32-yarder at 14:14 followed by a pair of TD rushes by **DeMarcus Blount** from one and two yards, respectively.

Blount led all players with 128 yards and two scores on 33 carries. **Quarterback Vinnie Saylor** completed 13-of-25 passes for 244 yards and a pair of TDs. The win was North Alabama's second over Valdosta State in two post-season meetings and upped its all-time series edge to 14-11-1.
