ARKANSAS TECH WONDER BOYS FOOTBALL SIGNS THREE MORE TO NATIONAL LETTERS OF INTENT

RUSSELLVILLE, Arkansas – Arkansas Tech University Head Football Coach and Athletic Director **Steve Mullins** has announced the signing of three additional players to National Football Letters of the Intent on Tuesday.

With the signing of these three players, the class now features 30 signees, including 20 high school players from the state of Arkansas.

Here are the latest signees for the Wonder Boys:

Jessie Harrison of Omaha, Texas (Paul-Pewitt High School): Harrison is a 6-foot, 205-pound running back and linebacker with 4.5 speed in the 40-yard dash. Rushed for 2,371 yards on 304 carries (7.8 yards per rush) and scored 37 touchdowns on offense and recorded 154 tackles, had two fumble recoveries, four forced fumbles, 11 quarterback sacks and 18 tackles for loss on defense. Was named an Associated Press Class 2-A Defensive Player of the Year and was the Texas Sportswriters Class 2-A Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year, which was the first time in the 55-year history of the award that the same player won both honors in the same season. In addition, was named the District 18-2A Most Valuable Offensive Back and was an All-Area selection at running back. Last season, he helped lead Paul-Pewitt H.S. to a 15-1 record and the Class 2A State finals.

Jimmy Mays of North Little Rock, Ark. (North Little Rock High School): Mays is a 6-foot-4, 300-pound defensive lineman. Credited last season with 51 tackles, five quarterback sacks and two forced fumbles. Earned All-Conference honors and helped lead the team to a 7-3 record in 2005.

Solomon Zachery of Opelousas, La. (Opelousas High School): Zachery is a 5-foot-11, 185 pound running back and defensive back. Was named a two-time All-District and two-time All-Parrish selection and was named the school's Offensive MVP this past season as a senior.
