***GOLF WORLD* ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF FIRST  
MEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE FALL SEASON**

***Georgia College Retains Top Spot in D-II Poll***

NEW YORK, NY—The first *Golf World*/Nike Golf Division II Coaches' Poll of the fall season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine, Nike Golf and the Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I, III and the NAIA, will appear in the September 28<sup>th</sup> issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online now at [www.golfworld.com](http://www.golfworld.com).

Georgia College remains the number one team in the poll, earning 9 of the 18 first place-votes. The Bobcats won their season opener, the Kiawah Island Invitational, by seven strokes and finished fifth at the SpringHill Suites Invitational, losing to three D-I programs.

Rounding out the top-five are Columbus State (No. 2), Barry (No. 3), Sonoma State (No. 4) and Lynn (No. 5)

Nova Southeastern (No. 9) cracked the top-10, after being ranked No. 11 in the preseason poll. Belmont Abbey (No. 22) moved into the top-25.
