Playing Experience:

Bayer lettered and started for four seasons as a setter at Grand Valley State University from 1997-00. As a player, she was a two-time All-Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference and two-time All-Great Lakes Region selection. In addition, as a senior, she was Second-Team NCAA All-American, a Third-Team Asics All-American the same year and a Daktronics All-Region pick. Holds the GVSU career assists record (5,441). Bayer was inducted into the Grand Valley State University Athletic Hall of Fame in 2007.

Coaching Experience:

Bayer was an assistant volleyball coach at her alma mater, Grand Valley State University (Mich.), in 2002 and 2003. With her on the staff, Grand Valley State posted back-to-back 30-win seasons, advanced to the NCAA Division II Final Four both seasons and finished in the top five of the final American Volleyball Coaches Association NCAA Division II top 25 poll both seasons. Prior to her stint at Grand Valley State, Bayer spent one year as an assistant coach at Emporia State (Kan.). She also has five years of experience coaching the Far Out club team in Michigan, one of the top club programs in the state of Michigan. In addition, she served as an assistant coach of the 2004 USA Youth National Performance Team Delta Region.

At Tech:

Bayer, who recently completed her fifth season with the Golden Suns with a 111-63 overall record. She guided Arkansas Tech to the Gulf South Conference Tournament in 2004, 2005, 2007, and 2008. In Bayer's five seasons, she has lead the suns to four seasons of 20 wins or more. In 2005, the suns finished 25-12 with a second place finish in the GSC West. In 2006, the Suns finished 22-13 and 8-4 in conference play. This past season, the Suns finished with an overall record of 31-5. They also clinched the GSC West Division Title with an 11-1 record. They were undefeated at home this year, posting a 19-0 record. Bayer was named GSC Coach of the Year.

General Camp Information

Overnight campers will be housed in Tech's air-conditioned dorms. Camp staff will be housed with campers to ensure safety. Overnight campers will need to bring bed linens and towels. All campers will need to bring workout gear and athletic shoes. Campers are also encouraged to bring a bathing suit for pool use.

Meals are included for ALL campers. Campers will dine in our full service campus cafeteria. No campers are allowed to leave the campus to eat, even commuter campers.

All sessions will be held in Tucker Coliseum or the Hull Building. All camp sessions are open to the public, family, and friends.

Each camper will receive a camp T-shirts.

All camps require a \$35 deposit which is non-refundable. You may pay the remainder of the fee during registration. All camps must be paid prior to the start of the camp. In case a camper pays the full amount prior to the start of camp and cannot attend, she may request and receive a refund for everything but the cost of the pre-registration deposit (\$35). The refund must be in writing and must be received by the camp director prior to the start of camp. After submitting your registration form and payment, you will receive additional information, schedule, insurance information, and confirmation about your specific camp.

We will accept personal checks, money orders, or cash at anytime.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

Each camper is covered by a secondary \$25 deductible excess medical insurance policy. This means that the camper's insurance policy is the primary coverage and the excess camp policy will pay what the primary policy will not. This policy is an accidental policy and will not cover illness. Only injuries occurring while the camper is enrolled in camp will be covered. The deductible must be paid before the camper check out of camp if there is an injury report filed.

Specialty Camp—June 28th

The Specialty Camp will allow players in developing their full potential in their chosen specialized position; setter, defensive specialist/libero, and/or attacker. This camp allows players to practice and refine their skills in their specific position. This is a one day commuter camp. \$65

Advanced Camp—June 29th & 30th

The camp is designed to meet the needs of the advanced to intermediate volleyball player with at least two years or more of organized game experience. This camp is best suited for someone who has played at the high school level and/or has had club level experience. Recommended for players entering 9th grade though 12th grade. **ADVANCED PLAYERS ONLY.** This camp is available for commuters at \$100 or overnight campers at \$125.

All-Skills Camp—July 12th-14th

Players attending this camp will receive in-depth individualized instruction emphasizing skill improvement and maximum number of contacts. The camp is designed to accommodate both overnight and commuter campers. Players will be divided according to skill level. This camp will touch on all skills, as well as the opportunity to play in a team setting. Recommended for players entering 6th grade through 12th grade. This camp is available for commuters at \$175 or overnight campers at \$225. Commuter campers will receive all meals except breakfast.
